Fact Sheet: 2004-2005 School Year

Student Enrollment

2004-2005:

206 students were enrolled in the Neighborhood Charter School for its third year of operation in the following grade level configuration –
3 Kindergarten classes of 15 children, 3 First grade classes of 20 children, 3 Second grade classes of 20 children, 1 Third grade class of 20 children, 1 fourth grade class of 20 children and 1 Fifth Grade Class of 20 children.

The student body for this year is most diverse. 30% of our students are in the free and reduced lunch program. 35% of our children live in single parent homes. The racial makeup of the students was -

51% - Black, 39% - Caucasian, 8% - Multi-racial, 2% - Hispanic and other

2005-2006:

Neighborhood Charter School will add one additional kindergarten class and two third grade classes for the 2005-2006 school year. This will increase the student body by 55 students. **93%** of the 2004-2005 student body re-enrolled for the 2005-2006 school year.
